Car Parking



The School car park is for the use of staff and visitors. Parents should not use the car park as this encourages children and adults to walk through it at the busiest times of our School day and could result in an accident. If you do bring your child to School by car please park in a safe place and with consideration to the local residents, and access the School by one of its two entrances – the Main Gate at the turning circle and the side gate which is on the route to the Cricket Pavilion.

Jewellery



Please remember that children should not wear jewellery to school, except for a small pair of stud earrings. If earrings are worn they must be removed, by the child, for P.E. lessons.

It should be noted that children will not be able to swim if they are wearing earrings. Earrings must be removed either by the child in school or be a parent before they come into school.

Outdoor Wear



Can you please ensure that your child has a warm coat, a hat and gloves in school each day for outdoor play and lunchtimes. In addition, it is advisable for them to bring in a track suit top and bottom, or something similar, for outdoor P.E. sessions, in particular for **Football coaching sessions on a Monday after school.**
